Message from the Head of School:

I've had a query this week regarding staff and DBS checks. All staff are required to have a DBS. Occasionally, one or two members of staff will start on a risk assessment whilst we are waiting for the DBS to come through. We wouldn't have more than one or two staff at a time on a risk assessment as it can become challenging to manage and there are restrictions regarding what these staff can do - for example, they can't be on their own with a child. We currently have a number of agency staff. Whilst we would prefer to have all staff be employed by us, the agency staff are very useful whilst we do have vacancies. The agency staff are subject to exactly the same checks as school staff, and we receive confirmation from the agencies of the satisfactory checks being completed.
