It has violence, murder, torture scenes, and bad language.

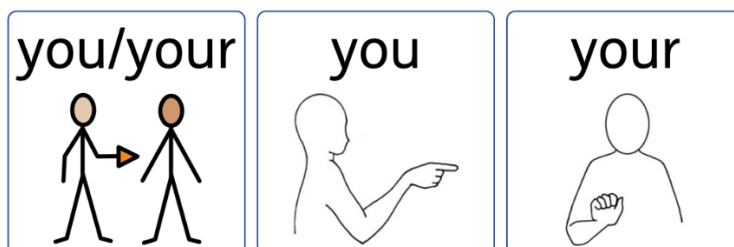
This film is **not appropriate** for any of your children here at Booker Park School to be viewing.
