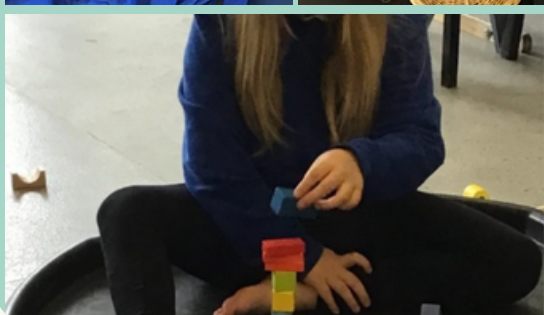

Loose parts play fosters creativity and imagination by encouraging children to use materials in open-ended and innovative ways. It values children's own ideas, interests, and problem-solving abilities, allowing them to take the lead in their learning rather than follow a predetermined activity directed by an adult. The Bluebird children particularly enjoy mixing, transporting, filling and emptying, and constructing with the loose parts resources. Through these engaging experiences, they are developing their creativity, independence, communication, and social skills as they collaborate, explore, and learn through play.

HS2

HS2 Works Notification: Notice of A418 Oxford Road Traffic Management.

We will be replacing the current mobile traffic lights, with fixed traffic lights on the A418 EKFB site entrance.

Location

A418 Oxford Road, between Coldharbour roundabout and Stone, opposite EKFB A418 compound site entrance.

Duration

1 day single lane closure, Monday 8 June, 9:30am to 3pm (off peak) 1 night full road closure, Tuesday 9 June to Wednesday 10 June, 10pm to 5am.

What to expect

1 day single lane closure 4-way temporary traffic lights, off peak 9.30am to 3pm. 1 night full road closure, with associated diversion route.

HS2 Works Notification: Notice of traffic management A4010 and Risborough Road.

We are completing outstanding minor works along the A4010 Stoke Mandeville Relief Road including curb and paving repairs and installing new signage. At the junction of Risborough Road and Old Risborough Road we are taking core samples from the road to inform future works in the area.

1 day at Risborough Road/Old Risborough Road, Monday 15 June, 8:30am-5:30pm
