LEAVERS HOODIES

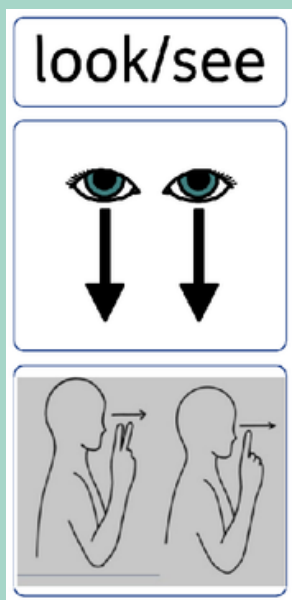
