

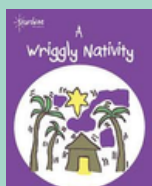

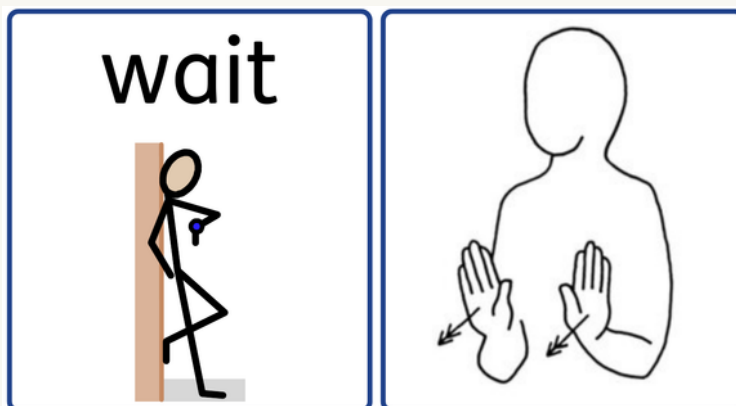

Please note: Arbor will still display the original meal choice, but the actual meal served will be the Christmas lunch. The cost of the Christmas lunch remains the same as a standard school meal (£3.00), and payment is already in place for those who previously ordered a meal for this day. If your child originally selected a jacket potato, packed lunch, or brings a packed lunch from home, you now have the option to switch to either the meat or vegetarian Christmas lunch. To do so, please complete this form by midnight on **Sunday 30th November**. [Click here](#) to complete the form. The payment request will then be added to your Arbor account. We're also pleased to confirm that pupils requiring special textured diets will have a Christmas lunch option available this year. If you have any queries, please contact the school office. 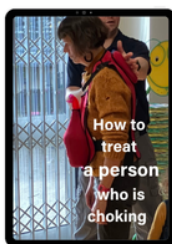
