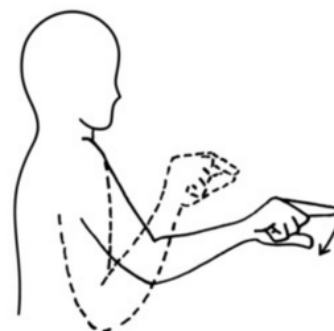
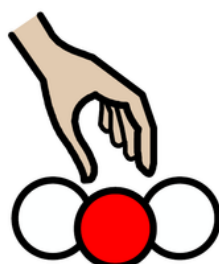

The cost of the Christmas lunch remains the same as a standard school meal (£3.00), and payment is already in place for those who previously ordered a meal for this day. If your child originally selected a jacket potato, packed lunch, or brings a packed lunch from home, you now have the option to switch to either the meat or vegetarian Christmas lunch.
