PLANNED ROAD WORKS IN AYLESBURY

HS2 Works Notification: Notice of daytime road closure, Ellesborough Road, Wendover

We will be cutting back overgrown vegetation, including hedges and weeds. This is to enable the installation of a low voltage cable on Ellesborough Road as part of the reinstatement of the road. A water pressure test will also be carried out on the existing Ellesborough Road.

HS2 Works Notification: Notice of road closure, Rocky Lane, Wendover

We are installing parapets on the Rocky Lane bridge. To enable these works, a road closure of Rocky Lane is required to install the parapets safely.
